Check-In Time

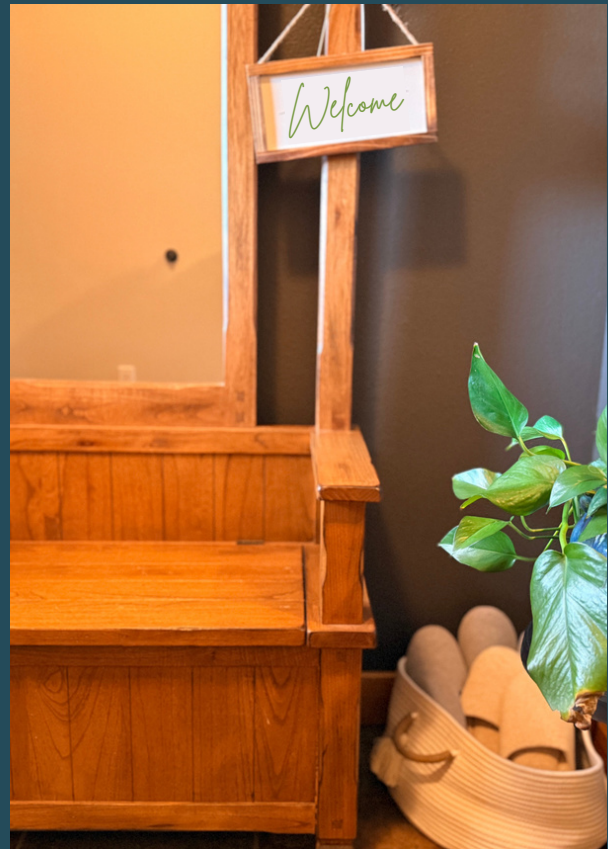
Check in time is at 10:00am.

House Rules

Lock the doors when you leave

- Anytime you leave the home, please press the lock button on the keypad to secure the door.

Septic Tank Care

- Please do not flush any products other than toilet paper.

Well Water

- The Eagle's Nest uses water from it's own well. For this reason, it is best to use the reverse osmosis water filter from the small spigot on the kitchen sink for drinking and cooking purposes.
- Larger groups sometimes like to bring extra bottled water for their stay.

No Moving Furniture

- Please refrain from moving any of the home's furniture.
- Dining chairs can be shifted to accommodate more seating in the living room areas.
- Please put any moved chairs back in the positions you found them.

No Food in Bedrooms

- Please keep your food and beverages in the main areas of the home.
- Please no food or drink in the bedrooms.

No Smoking

- Please refrain from smoking in or around the house.
- If needed, we encourage a walk off-property for any smoking activity.

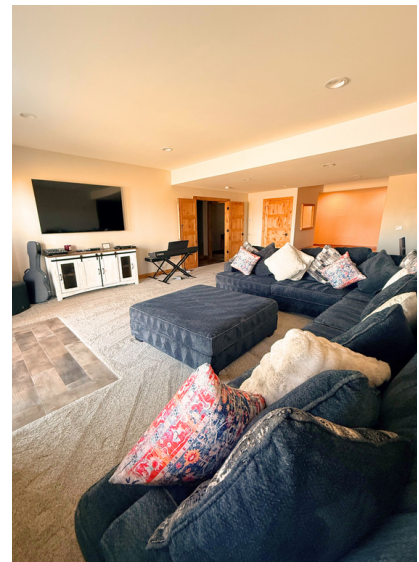

Check-Out List

Trash

Dishes

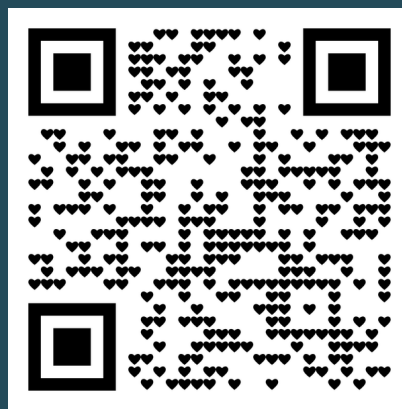
- Please place any remaining dirty dishes in the dishwasher and start a cycle before you go.

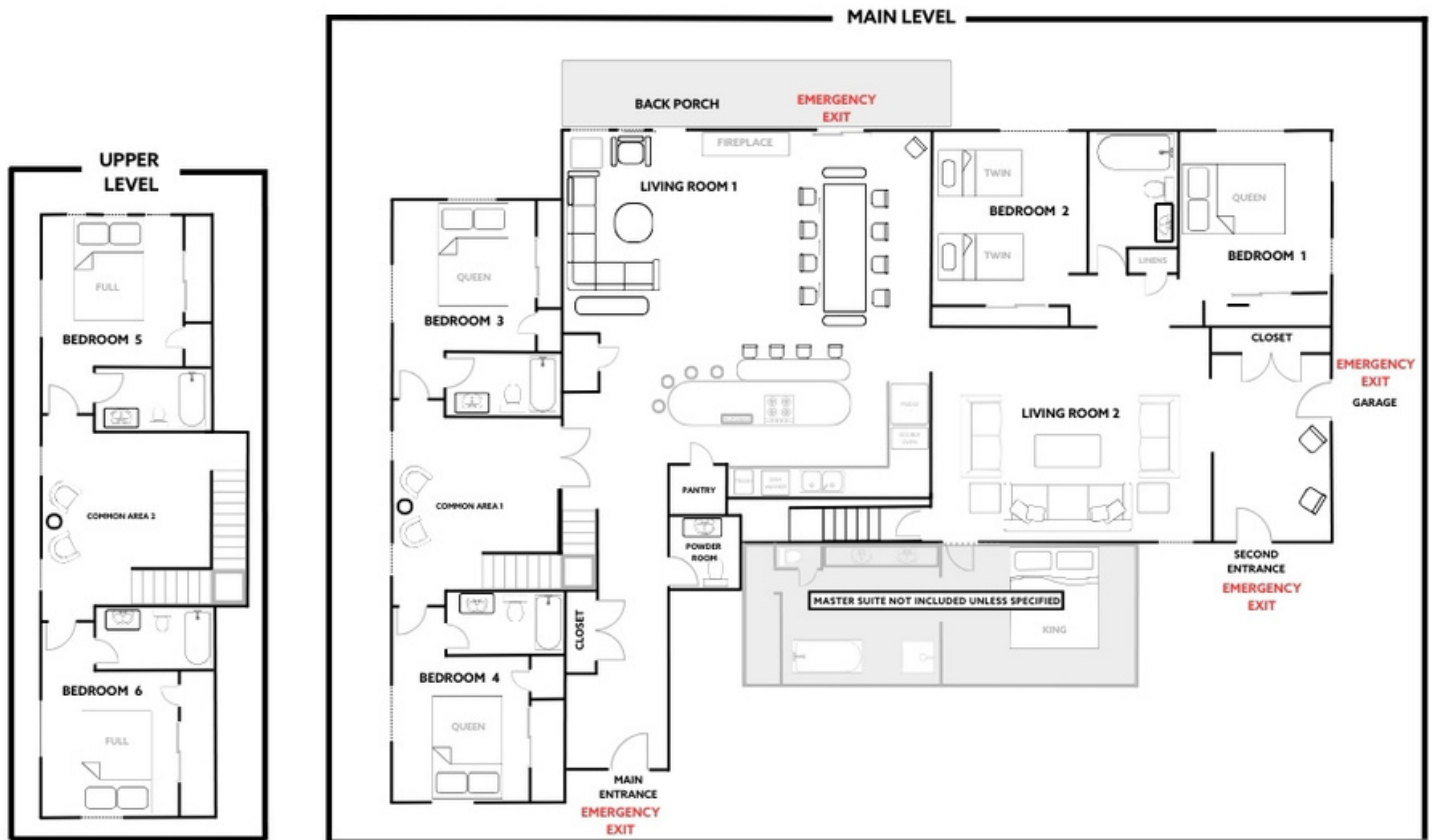
